Hearing Assistance - Devices are available at the Welcome Desk. Ask an usher for instructions.

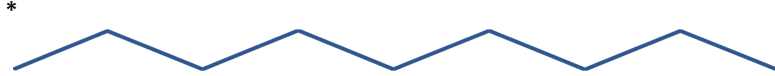
